Subject: Policy of Not Accepting All Kinds of Presents and Gifts
from Performing Duties (No Gift Policy)
for the Fiscal Year B.E. 2568 (2025)

The Secretariat of the Senate, as a subordinate parliamentary agency, has continually placed importance on the building of an anti-corruption and misconduct culture in accordance with good governance. The Secretariat of the Senate has participated in the Integrity and Transparency Assessment (ITA) since the Fiscal Year B.E. 2557 (2014) for promoting and supporting moral and ethical conduct as well as transparency among all officials of the Secretariat of the Senate.

Therefore, the Secretary-General of the Senate as the head of the Secretariat of the Senate would like to declare the Policy of Not Accepting All Kinds of Presents and Gifts from Performing Duties (No Gift Policy). The purpose is to promote the acknowledgement of persons, agencies, society or the general public that the Secretariat of the Senate **is an agency which the executives and all officials in the agency do not accept all kinds of presents and gifts before, during and after performing duties** and do not perform the duties which are contrary to various laws, regulations and announcements resulting in the corruption and misconduct from performing duties.
